Learn about the planned replacement of Penn Park Reservoir

City of Bothell intends to replace the existing potable water storage tank located in Penn Park to increase its storage capacity, as identified in the City's adopted Water Comprehensive Plan. The new tank is proposed to be in the same location as the existing tank, and is expected to be constructed in early spring 2015.
